2. Department Reports: Police Chief Dennis Bell reported on the number of calls in May. He reported that Oglethorpe County would use the speed detection trailer and a grant application was progressing. Chief Bell reported that he would be the district coordinator for the Department of Highway Safety. Speeding along the new 4 Lane was discussed along with the extension of SR22 from its current ending point at the old SR 72 to the 4 lane intersection.

Mayor Blackmon reported on Public Works. The rain has put the crew behind on the grass cutting. Council discussed a proposed sewer line rehab and progress on repair of fire hydrants.

3. Police Citation and Court Software: Mr. James Bragg with CourtWare gave a presentation on a software system to record citations and track Municipal Court Cases. General consensus of Council was to proceed with evaluation of the system.

4. Beer and Wine License: Motion by Council Member Yarbrough to approve a 2018 Beer and Wine License for Mahalaxmi Comer, LLC located in the store commonly referred to as the Bread Basket. Motion second by Council Member Farren. Motion approved by unanimous vote of Council.
