

## **WATERING SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JUNE 10, 2009**

On June 10, 2009, Governor Perdue announced that due to significant rainfall and improved water supplies, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has issued a non-drought schedule for outdoor water use. Under a non-drought schedule, EPD drought management guidelines allow outdoor water use three days a week on assigned days using odd and even numbered addresses. Odd-numbered addresses are allowed to water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays. Even-numbered addresses are allowed to water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Water use may occur at any time of day on assigned days, however, landscape watering is not recommended between 10am and 4pm because of limited effectiveness.
