Mayor Pro Tem Booth called the meeting to order.

- 1) **Minutes:** Motion by Council Member Threlkeld to approve the minutes of the September 14, 2009 City of Comer Regular Council Meeting. Motion second by Council Member Laquita Bridges. Motion approved by unanimous vote of Council.
- 2) **Called Meeting:** Called Council Meeting has been set for Thursday October 22, 2009 at 2:00 to set Millage Rates.
- 3) **Tax Sale:** Tax sale scheduled for tomorrow, October 6, 2009 on the City Hall Steps. Two properties up for sale.
- 4) **Royal Oaks Home Owners Association:**
 - a) Inquired if monthly debris schedule had been set. Mayor Pro Tem Booth explained that that is still be worked on; however, when the schedule is set it will only affect Phase I and Phase II of the subdivision. Phase III has yet to be dedicated to the City.
 - b) Parade—verified date set, and offered to help. Council Member Laquita Bridges suggested calling Mrs. Sueletta Sorrells.
 - c) Reindeer Run—requested information. Redirected to Madison County Recreation Department
 - d) StreetLights—inquired if once Phase III was dedicated to the City if the streetlights would be turned back on. Redirected to Developer.
- 5) **Laurel Avenue:** Citizens requested speed bumps on Laurel Avenue, at least temporarily. Council Member Laquita Bridges stated that you could no longer put temporary speed bumps down, that they would have to be like the ones in front of the High School. Police Chief Brent Zellner offered to set up on Laurel Avenue to help with the situation.
- 6) **Limbs on Prince:** Council Member Laquita Bridges request that the public works department clear limbs on Prince because the school bus can not travel safely with limbs as they are.
- 7) **November 2, Council Meeting:** Council Member Howard Threlkeld made a motion to move the November 2, 2009 Regular Council Meeting from 6:00 to 2:00. Council Member Laquita Bridges second the motion. Council Member Melissa Yarbrough refrained.
- 8) **Limbs in Alley:** Council Member Howard Threlkeld request that the public works department clear overhanging limbs from right of way of alley from Madison Street to Main Street.

Motion by Council Member Howard Threlkeld to adjourn. Motion second by Council Member Melissa Yarbrough. Motion approved by unanimous vote of Council.
